## **SNORKELING EXCURSIONS**

- S.Angelo La Roja: you can immerse by the little beach of the fishermen village of S. Angelo, among anemones and hermit crabs and you arrive to the rock outcropping of the Roja, on the edge of a submarine slope. A dive where the sea is a blue table!

The proposed excursions provide a starting from the ground. Optional excursion on demand, including on board.

## Snorkeling course and Mention on Mediterranean marine Biology

Two-days course divided into: 3 theoretical lessons - including two about snorkeling techniques, planning, safety procedures and one of Mediterranean marine biology - and three practical lessons - including 2 carried out the same day (morning and afternoon) about techniques and the following day about Mediterranean marine biology. Issue of international certification (patent) of snorkeling PSS.



Excursion includes the supply of **complete equipment**.

Meeting at the chosen site – introduction to the Mediterranean and Ischia biology – excursion – discussions on the observed life forms. **Total time: about 2 h**.
